Nestled in the heart of the **Napa Valley**, the 33-acre property is surrounded by stunning views of sprawling vineyards, mountain ranges, sunsets and moon rises. **Villa Monticello**, {Tuscan inspired} was built out of castle stone. The gated property includes resort-style grounds, four decks, over 4,500 sq. ft. of outdoor entertainment space.

The Villa can accommodate groups of up to 200 guests, {sleeps 10}. A 15-minute drive to **St Helena**, 20 minutes to **Calistoga**. Security services and secure transportation are available. A 30-minute drive from the Villa is docked the **Jazzy Lady**, a 44' Bayliner, available with captain for groups of up to 16.



Hemingway wrote ["Kiki dominated the Era of Montparnasse more than Queen Victoria ever dominated the Victorian Era"](#). The two also shared a brief affair. 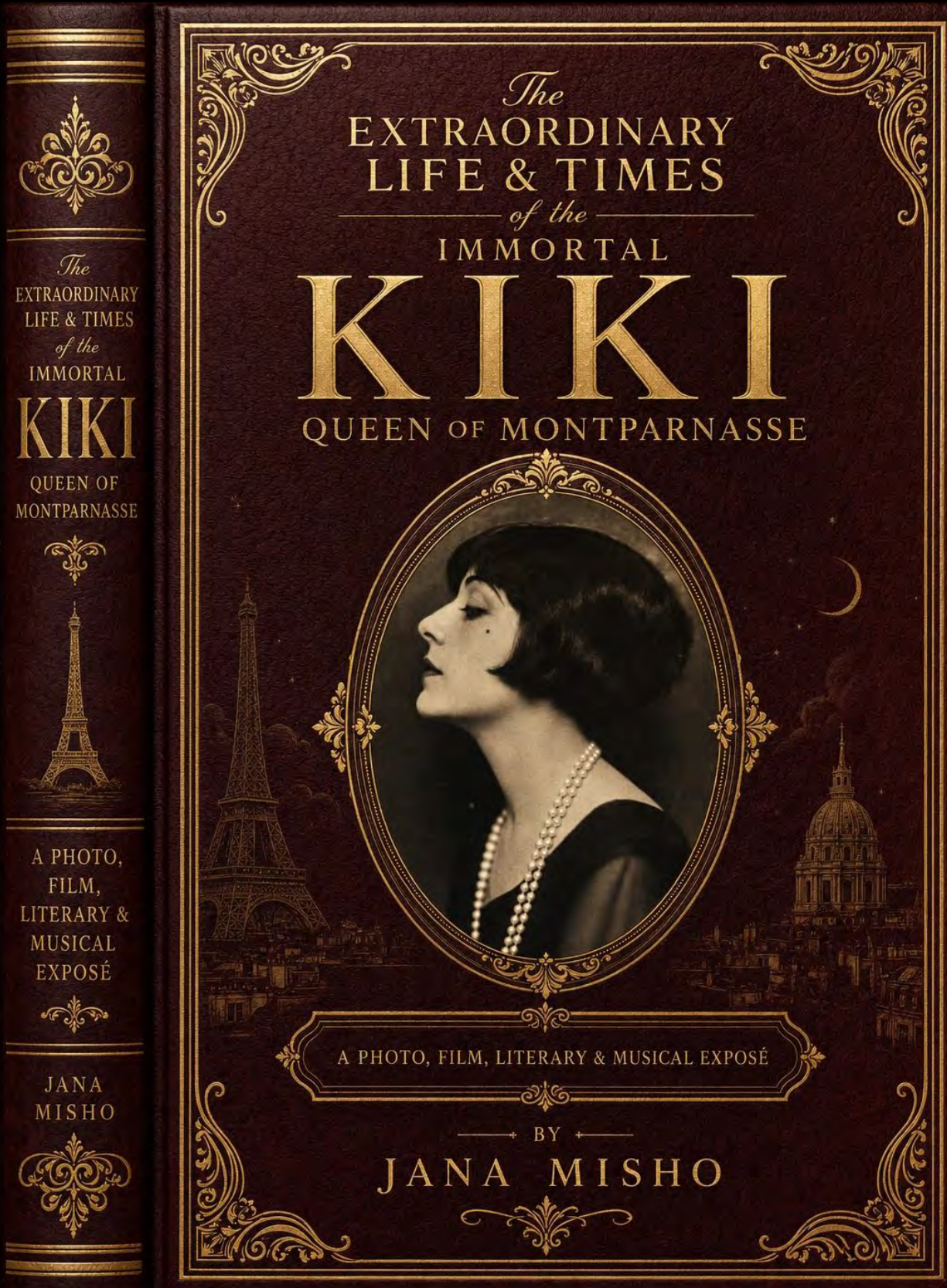

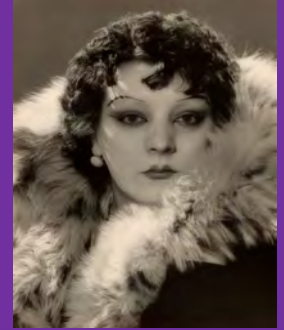

The Extraordinary Life & Times of the Immortal yet Forgotten KIKI, "Queen of Montparnasse" - an Exposé & Graphic Novel -- Backstory from Author

It all began four years ago, trying to help a friend find a loan against a painting he represented by [Amedeo Modigliani](#). The lender asked me to research the Subject of the painting. I was planning to prepare a few pages. Although once I got started I was so taken by the story, I was hooked. A few pages turned into over 7,500 hours of research and file assembly of 228 pages. The journey was truly a labor of love, the spirit of Kiki with me throughout. An artist recreation on the wall next to me. At times it felt as if Kiki was in the room, looking over my shoulder, guiding my keystrokes. Sometimes 24 and 48 hours sessions without sleep. I was caught up in the excitement of Kiki's remarkable story, a phenomenal time in history. My wife thought had lost my mind. Interspersed throughout the Exposé are 700+ carefully curated Research Links. Many to very rare period films, photos, animation and interviews with art historians and curators. All of the content beyond the published articles was written based on my research.

Through an incredible twist of fate, I am now the exclusive representative of the painting, [Sitting Nude with Crossed Hands](#), (c.) 1917. Modigliani, who died in 1920 {age 35} would never know his vivacious young model and favorite muse, [Alice Prin](#) would go on to become an icon in avant-guard/bohemian Paris during the roaring 1920s. The "essential interlocutor" for two generations of Modigliani's peers. Artists today whose paintings are worth billions. Not a thought four years ago, but now the Exposé will serve as an important historical document on the Subject of Modigliani's masterwork. The painting will soon be on tour {Exhibition}, after which it will likely be sold at Christie's.

The Introduction {w/links} is a warm-up to what readers will experience while immersed in the content and stunning visuals. Another novel devoted to Kiki, a NY Times bestseller, [KIKI-MAN RAY](#) by Mark Braude has sold over 500,000 copies worldwide. By his own admission Mr. Braude's research picks up Kiki's story in 1922 when she was bestowed the first half of her title, "[Kiki de Montparnasse](#)" soon after meeting and falling in love with [Man Ray](#). The Exposé, albeit in a different format, fills the decade of Kiki's life from 1913-1922. Arguably the most influential/consequential years of Alice Prin's short life. A life well-lived that ended so tragically and without the recognition she so richly deserved *until now*.

A successful Paris line of lingerie, [Kiki de Montparnasse - Luxury Lingerie & Related Goods - The Brand](#) adopted Kiki's likeness and namesake. My literary agent has spoken with an executive at the company and she has proposed the creation of a Deluxe Edition of their Catalog. A leather-bound version would include their models wearing an exclusive vintage line of lingerie targeted to their most loyal customers. Part of the proceeds could be donated to a foundation that is currently being established in Montparnasse. Its mission to support causes that if Kiki were alive today would be near/dear to her heart.

The release of the Exposé will be targeted initially to of Kiki's super-fans, by some estimates over a million strong. Most who subscribe to dozens of YouTube Channels that are all about Kiki in one way or another. The audio-book is planned for release in June, including a picture book to follow along with while listening. For social media, we have arranged access to over 40 extremely rare films, many in French {w/English subtitles} from the 1920's. Several other rare films that are relatively unknown, filmed in the US, in Alice's later years, never widely distributed. The films will stream 24x7 free of charge to Exposé enthusiasts. Random visitors will access a pay-per-view model. Many short films that Kiki played a role, she is not given mention in the official credits. Most of these films were produced by Man Ray. I discovered them by watching every film that Man Ray ever produced, I believe these films are not known to the public, especially to Kiki's fan base.

The Exposé is dedicated to my mom, may God rest her soul, who told me throughout my life, "Richard, there is a book in you".
